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## THE WA FAMILY AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COMMON RISK ASSESSMENT RISK MANAGEMENT FRAMEWORK

The *WA Family and Domestic Violence Common Risk Assessment and Risk Management Framework (CRARMF)* is designed to support integrated responses to family and domestic violence in Western Australia. The CRARMF sits across the entire WA service sector (mainstream and specialist, government and non-government) and sets common minimum practice standards for family and domestic violence (FDV) screening and the assessment, management and monitoring of risk.

### TRAINING CALENDAR

This training calendar details four training options for service providers in Western Australia including:

- *WA FDV Common Risk Assessment and Risk Management Framework Training (2 days)*. This course is offered in the metropolitan area for service providers who have a primary role in responding to family and domestic violence.
- *WA FDV Common Risk Assessment and Risk Management Framework Refresher (1 day)*. This course is offered in country locations and is targeted at service providers who have a primary role in responding to family and domestic violence. This course is for people who have not previously attended CRARMF training.
- *Advance Practice: Working with Risk: FDV and safety planning (1 day)*. This course is for people who have previously completed the CRARMF Training (2 days) or the one day CRARMF Refresher.
- *WA FDV Common Risk Assessment and Risk Management Framework Train the Trainer (2 days)*. This course provides opportunities for service providers or training facilitators to be trained to deliver the CRARMF training materials. CRARMF Train the Trainer is specifically targeted at trainers that have key responsibility for workforce development within their organisations or departments and is designed to assist organisations in their implementation strategies.

### WORKING WITH RISK: FDV & SAFETY PLANNING

The Department for Child Protection, Family and Domestic Violence Unit is offering an extension training opportunity for those who have already completed a CRARMF training day/s and would like to undertake further learning in relation to how to incorporate risk management and safety planning into their work with clients experiencing family and domestic violence. This one day course will explore:

- The necessity and value of individual and interagency safety planning
- Working with risk – decision making in survival modality – what does this look like and how can we work with it to promote safety?
- Promoting perpetrator accountability in the context of safety planning
- The practical application of risk management strategies using case studies.
- Working with victims of family and domestic violence in developing a safety plan – what does this look like in practice?
- Working in the interagency context to promote safety for clients.

### CRARMF TRAIN THE TRAINER

The Department for Child Protection, Family and Domestic Violence Unit is offering a unique training opportunity for those who have already completed a CRARMF training course. The Train the trainer course is specifically targeted at trainers that have key responsibility for workforce development within their organisations or departments and is designed to assist organisations in their implementation strategies. This two day course will focus on:

- Overview and summary of the WA FDV Common Risk Assessment and Risk Management Framework.
- Family and domestic violence – in depth dynamics, patterns of behaviours, impacts and associated theoretical understandings.
- Engaging with multiple systems – victim, perpetrator and agency/service provider perspectives.
- What are the challenges of delivering family and domestic violence training? How can participants meet those challenges and facilitate learning?
- Critical reflective practices – how to engage and promote the concept of critical reflection and its relevance to understanding family and domestic violence.
