



Prescribed authorities

Regulation 20A of the *Children and Community Services Regulations 2006* prescribes the Western Australian public authorities that are able to use the information sharing powers in section 28B of the *Children and Community Services Act 2004*. They are referred to as ***prescribed authorities***.
